Shortened version:

I exhort you to:

We're tired; we're tired of living it; and, we're tired of reliving it for you.

I say this with love – I am doing what Jesus taught me to do.

Rely on the strength of your faith, guided by the holy spirit to do that heavy lifting yourselves.
